Licensed medical professionals conduct free ultrasounds, pregnancy tests and options education.



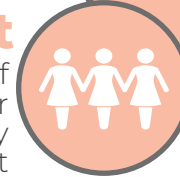
Educate

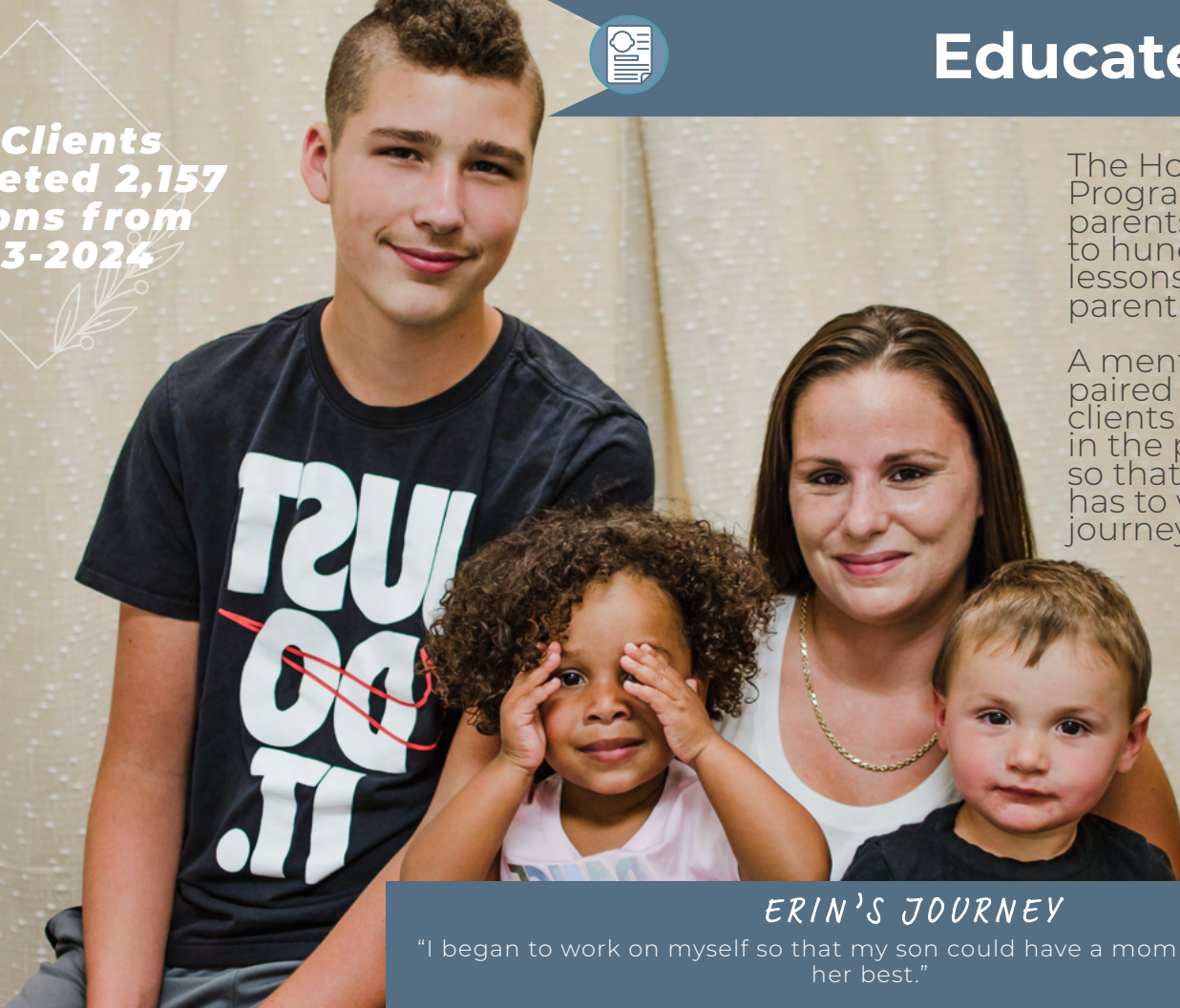


Educate

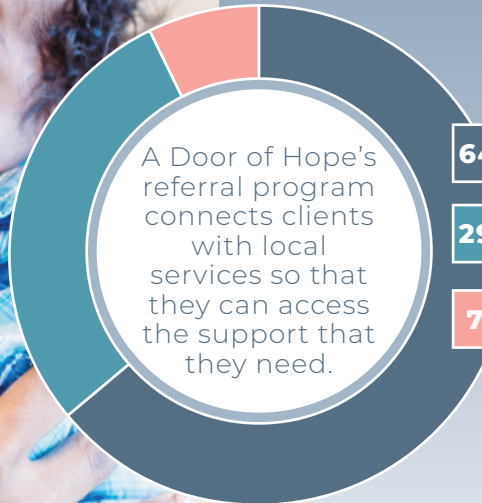

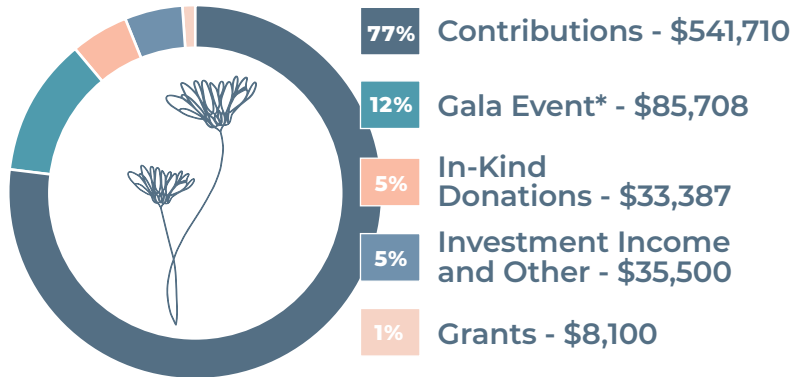

Fiscal Year 2023 - 2024

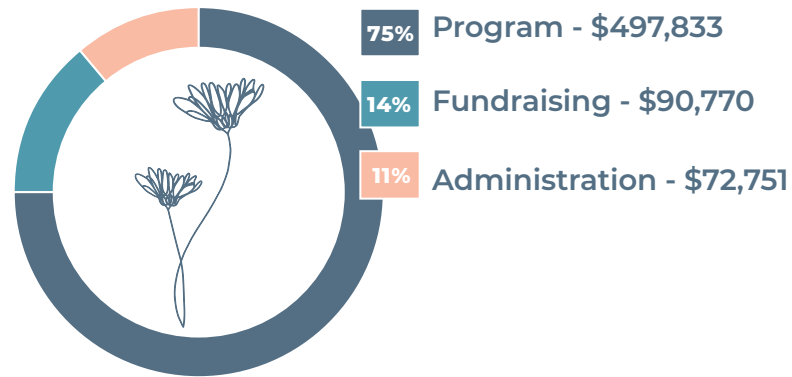
Total Income
