Delaware HIV Consortium

The CDC recommends testing for HIV as a routine part of medical care for all persons ages 13-64 (HIV testing should be routine for people over aged 64 as well if you are sexually active or if you share needles to inject drugs). If you engage in higher risk behaviors (unprotected sex or share needles to inject drugs) it is best to be tested every three to six months. The sooner that a person finds out that they are HIV positive, the less likely they are to pass along the infection to others. FREE in-home test kits are available by signing up HERE.
